**Rules:**

- All schools are responsible for acquiring canned food or obtaining a Supply Sponsor.
- All food donated and used for the CAN-structure must be unopened. All labels must remain intact.
- Structures must fit within the building area(s) selected by each elementary school.
- Structures must be completely self-supporting with no framework or other structural support. ¼" sheets of foam-core, cardboard, plywood, or similar material can be used as a leveling device between rows of cans. Schools may obtain a Supply Sponsor for any materials.
- Canned food may be wrapped with colored paper to assist with design and joined using tape, Velcro, fishing line, wire, rubber bands, zip ties or any other mounting method that provides easy demounting, *provided labels and cans are NOT damaged*. NO gluing or other permanent affixing of cans allowed. A Supply Sponsor may be utilized for materials.
- No glass containers, alcohol, pet food, perishable, damaged or open packages of food are permitted.
- Each CAN-structure needs to be named with a written description and number of cans used.
- CAN-structure completed & pictures submitted by March 10, 2023.

**Safety Precautions:**

- Closed toe shoes when building structure.
- No running or horseplay.
- Do not distract the attention of builders.
- No power tools.
- Adult must be present when building.
- Structure area roped off.
